## Tommy Taylors Lane, Cheltenham

Dear Sir/Madam

**What:** Road closure for carriageway resurfacing

Where: Tommy Taylors Lane, Cheltenham – see overleaf for details of the exact location

**When:** 30<sup>th</sup> May – 8<sup>th</sup> June (not including weekends), from 0730 to 1730 daily

On behalf of Gloucestershire County Council, Amey will shortly be resurfacing the road at the above location in two phases.

To ensure the safety of road users and our workforce, it will be necessary for us to **close the road** because of the road width and machinery that will be used. Overleaf is a map that shows the areas that will be closed to vehicles on the following dates:

- Southern end of Tommy Taylors Lane to the junction with Prince Regent Avenue 30<sup>th</sup> May to 1<sup>st</sup> June
- Northern end of Tommy Taylors Lane from Prince Regent Avenue up to Swindon Road 2<sup>nd</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> June

We hope you understand that we will not be able to guarantee access for vehicles in or out of our work area (solid red line on map overleaf) except in emergencies. If you normally drive into or out of this area during the hours when the closure will be in place, we ask you to please make alternative arrangements. Please also avoid leaving parked vehicles on the road. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout.

While we resurface the southern end vehicles will still be able to access the northern end of Tommy Taylors Lane from the Swindon Lane direction and vice versa. We are resurfacing in two phases in order to maintain access for residents of Prince Regent Avenue and the other cul-de-sacs that lead off it.

The road closure area (dotted red line on map overleaf) extends beyond the work area to help us manage through-traffic and a signed diversion will be in place. However we will do all we can to provide access for residents and businesses in the road closure area where it extends beyond the work area.


