Ongoing upgrade of equipment – Brockhampton Lane level crossing

We wanted to inform you that the level crossing on Brockhampton Lane is due to reopen on Monday 5 April, following urgent work to the signalling and telecoms equipment. We would like to thank you for your ongoing patience and apologise for the inconvenience the closure has caused.

Please note that you may see the crossing barriers going up and down between Monday 29 March and Sunday April 4 as we carry out tests on the equipment. The crossing **remains closed** to pedestrians and vehicles during this time. Please do not use it until we fully reopen on Monday 5.

As part of our ongoing project to upgrade signalling in the area, we need to replace two signals near the crossing. Work will take place during the below dates and times while trains aren't operating so our teams can work safely.

Please be aware these dates may change.

As part of this work, our machinery will need to access the railway at the crossing on Saturday 29 May. This means we will need to close the level crossing twice that evening and twice on the morning of Sunday 30 May for a period of around 15 minutes using stop/go boards. We are sorry for any inconvenience this may cause.

Our teams are aware that they are working close to your home and try to minimise disruption as much as possible, but we apologise in advance if you are disturbed during this work. Our teams are taking all necessary precautions to keep each other safe and prevent the spread of Covid-19 by working within current Government guidelines.
