Why register to vote?

If you want to have a say in your area and make your voice heard, you need to register to vote. Using your vote gives you a say on decisions that affect you day to day such as; the amount of tax you pay; how much money is spent and where; if planning permission is granted or refused; what children learn at school and how climate change is tackled.

It's easier than you think

Go to www.gov.uk/register-to-vote and complete the online form. You will need your National Insurance Number to hand.

How can I check I am registered to vote?

Each year before an election you will receive a poll card, provided you are eligible to vote in that election. The council also sends out a household enquiry form each year, usually around August, to each property in Cheltenham to check records are correct.

To check if you are on the register you will need to phone the elections office, they cannot confirm over email.
